

PRIMARY SCHOOLS TOURNAMENT

This year the DAV ran Primary School Debating Programs in 10 regions across Victoria. The programs involved 87 teams from 29 different schools, with around 400 students participating.

As a capstone to this program, we would like to invite participating schools to send one team to participate in a round-robin style debating tournament in Term 4. As well as providing an opportunity to further develop debating skills and receive feedback from DAV adjudicators, the competition aims to introduce students to competitive inter-school debating.

Teams will take part in three debates on the day. Two of the debates will be prepared beforehand by teams on topics which will be published at the close of registration. The final debate is a secret topic, and will be announced on the day. All teams will be given 50 minutes to prepare for the secret topic, as they were in the Primary Program.

After the debates, presentations will be made to congratulate winning teams and the highest scoring speakers.

We hope that all schools who participated in this year's programs will be able to send a team to participate in the DAV's inaugural Primary Schools Debating Tournament.
